
- The applicant will be waived 50% of the total course fees after signing a bond with the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

- Other conditions stipulated in UGC circulars, internal circulars, council decisions, etc., will be applicable where necessary.

All relevant staff members who have an interest to follow a master degree program are requested to apply for the following three master degree programs.

- Master of Sociology
 Degree Program
- Master of Development Planning Degree Program
- Master of Business Administration (MBA)

This scholarship scheme is designed to encourage and support nonacademic staff pursuit of higher education while balancing professional responsibilities. We encourage all eligible nonacademic staff members to take advantage of this opportunity to enhance their skills and qualifications.
