

VICE-CHANCELLOR'S GOLD MEDAL FOR THE BEST POSTGRADUATE STUDENT - 2024

All PhD and M.Phil. students who will graduate at the convocation scheduled for December 2024 are invited to apply for the above award. The application and the eligibility criteria are mentioned below.

Duly filled applications, along with all supporting documents, should reach the address below on or before **15.10.2024**.

Incomplete and late applications will be rejected.

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SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Research degree (MPhil/PhD) holders who will be graduated at the forthcoming convocation are eligible to apply for the award.
2. An MPhil holder shall complete the degree within 42 months (36 months + 6 months) and a PhD holder shall complete the degree within 60 months (54 months + 6 months) to be eligible to apply
3. Applicants shall prepare a self-evaluation according to the given format to be submitted with the application
4. Only the facts relevant to the Postgraduate degree and the thesis will be considered in evaluation of applications. (Qualifications completed after the closing date of the applications will not be considered for the evaluation)
5. Publications in fake/predatory journals shall not be claimed in the self-evaluation. If any Publication from Fake/Predatory journals is included, the applicant will be disqualified
6. Candidate should attach the necessary documentary evidence to prove each fact he/she claims marks for. **If the candidate fails to provide such proofs, the relevant fact/competency will not be considered in the evaluation.**
7. Candidates with MPhil degrees shall obtain a minimum of **210 marks** to be qualified for the award. Candidates with PhD degrees shall obtain a minimum of **270 marks** to be qualified for the award
8. Applications shall be handed over to the Dean's office, Faculty of Graduate Studies or send to Dean, Faculty of Graduate Studies, No 115, Sri Dharmarama Mawatha, Fort, Matrara, by registered post.

The application should include;

- i. A completed application form
 - ii. A complete self-assessment report prepared according to the marking scheme
 - iii. Relevant documentary evidence
9. The evaluation will be conducted based on the submitted documents by a committee appointed by the Board of Graduate Studies. Evaluations will be conducted for MPhil and PhD degrees separately, and the Gold Medals will be awarded to the MPhil and PhD degree holders who obtain the highest marks.
